About the position:

Overview: We seek a talented and driven person to serve as an aide to the Executive Director and the chair of the Resource Development Committee with a focus on institutional fundraising, grants research and grant writing. This position requires approximately 5 hours of time per week and will be compensated at a rate of \$10.00/hour.

The ideal candidate will have interest or experience in nonprofit administration, arts and music, and/or education. Strong verbal and written communications, attention to detail, and the ability to meet deadlines are critical characteristics of a successful candidate. Interest in international organizations, familiarity working in Haiti or within Haitian or Haitian Diaspora communities, and/or French or Haitian Kreyol language skills is not necessary, but certainly a plus.
